

Opportunities For All— Drop-in Support



Who is it aimed at?

Drop-ins are weekly sessions which are run by our Opportunities for All Partnership Team, they take place throughout Angus for young people aged approximately 16-19 who are not currently engaged in training, education or employment and looking for support and guidance in skills for life and work.

What prior skills, achievements and experience are needed?

No appointments are necessary and participants come with a range of qualifications, experience and needs.

What do they involve?

Drop-ins provide access to individual support from a range of staff. Young people can come along for a coffee and a chat or plan to undertake more specific pieces of work.

What will be the benefits?

Drop-ins help young people to:

- to explore future goals and aspirations
- access resources such as My World of Work and Universal Job Match
- develop cv's and complete job applications
- and explore the range of opportunities available

What are the next steps?

Apply for college courses, secure employment, a place with a training provider or an extended work experience placement. Alternatively sign up for some of the opportunities available to help you move closer to achieving this.
